Client Profile

The Sacramento Observer is a weekly newspaper serving the African American community in Sacramento, California. Established in 1962, it has been a vital source of news, information, and commentary for its community for over six decades. The newspaper covers local news, politics, education, health, and cultural events, with a particular focus on issues affecting the African American community in Sacramento. In recent years, The Sacramento Observer has been working to enhance its digital presence while maintaining its strong connection to the local community.

Challenge

The Sacramento Observer faced several challenges in its efforts to modernize and expand its reach:

- 1. Digital Adaptation: Transitioning from a primarily print model to a more comprehensive digital strategy.
- 2. Content Discoverability: Ensuring their local, community-focused content was easily discoverable online.
- 3. Audience Expansion: Maintaining their core readership while attracting younger, digitally-native audience members.

- 4. Resource Limitations: As a small, independent publication, they had limited staff and resources to dedicate to digital initiatives.
- 5. Competitive Landscape: Standing out in an increasingly crowded digital news environment while maintaining their unique voice.

Solution
